

FAQs

1) How many Bid Forms can I submit?

We would recommend that your organisation submits at least two Bid Forms – one form opting for the Lower Limit of Funding and one for the Upper Limit of Funding.

2) Can I submit a Bid Form as a single bid and as part of a consortium bid?

Yes.

Ealing Prevent Moderation Panel

The Moderation Panel will take place on 15th November and will use the following Scoring Guide to consider your Ealing Prevent Bids:

SCORING:

- 5 The bid fully addresses the local threat within the area and contains relevant evidence to support this, is unambiguous and demonstrates a thorough understanding of the threat and provides details of how this will be met in full. Provides strong value for money and contingencies are in place for delivery.
- 4 The bid addresses all or most of the local threat within the area and/or the response contains some relevant evidence, but the response either fails to meet all of the threat areas or lacks sufficient evidence. Provides value for money and contingencies are in place for delivery.
- 3 The bid addresses some of the local threat within the area, but fails to address the majority of it. The response contains some evidence to demonstrate meeting the threat but the evidence does not indicate an understanding of these. Value for money case not made and/ or no contingencies in place for delivery.
- 2 Submission fails to address the local threat within the area, contains insufficient evidence or information is irrelevant to meeting the threat. Value for money case not made and no contingencies in place for delivery.
- 1 Nil or inadequate response. Totally fails to meet the needs within the area and contains no supporting evidence. Value for money case not made and no contingencies in place for delivery.
