What is a Parent/Carer Champion?

Parent/Carer Champions are parents/carers of children and young people who are passionate about improving the safety for young people in their community. They will bring a **wealth of diverse life experiences**, and **solutions** which are invaluable to the community.

They will volunteer on a regular basis to support and **empower** local parents/carers in their community by offering advice, peer support & providing information about services. Parent/Carer Champions will use their **knowledge** of local agencies/organisations to be **trusted advocates** for parents/carers who may be isolated or are reluctant to access support.

Parent/Carer Champions will be a bridge between the local authority and parents/carers, so that we can provide a whole community approach to safeguarding children/young people and reduce preconceptions about statutory services. They will raise awareness about child exploitation and aim to reduce the stigma around children/young people who are involved in the criminal justice system.
