CHILDREN MISSING EDUCATION (CME)

The function of identifying and preventing CME falls on the support from many service areas and is not solely the responsibility of the CME officer. Partnership working is imperative, to ensure that no child is missing education, and there is a whole system approach when trying to track children missing education.
